We are already preparing for recital!

Throughout the month of November, we will be measuring for recital costumes. Please make sure that your child is in attendance. We always add extra inches in order to ensure that growing room is accounted for. Often, minor alterations are still necessary. Please inquire in our office about the most convenient and cost-effective businesses that can assist you with this, should the need arise. Please be advised your performance package fees and 1st costume deposit must be paid by November 15 for us to order your student's costumes.

Flu Season is here

Please be aware of the attendance guidelines in our studio handbook. While perfect attendance is encouraged and appreciated, the health of our dancers is of utmost importance. Please be on the lookout for all communicable illnesses.

PLEASE keep your child home if they have any of the following symptoms: fever, eyes that are pink, burning, itching, or producing discharge, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or known or suspected communicable diseases such as lice, flu, COVID, or strep throat.

Please observe the 24-hour fever free and symptom free rule before allowing your child to return to dance in the case of any illness that is not COVID. As always, follow the SDDA and ADH guidelines for Covid.


